Certified Court Interpreters perform literal and general interpretation in Superior Court proceedings and interviews requiring fluency in English and a foreign language. Court Interpreters may also be called upon to provide sight translations of court documents (reading written texts and giving an oral translation of text). This classification performs duties as an interpreter in the courtroom and in other legal proceedings. Individuals appointed to this classification must be certified as a Court Interpreter in the State of California.

Possession of a valid certificate as a Court Interpreter in the State of California and possession of a valid Class C California Driver's License is required at the time of appointment.

Interested candidates should submit a completed and signed Court application form and a copy of your valid certification as a Certified Court Interpreter issued by the Judicial Council on behalf of the State of California.
