*A filing fee is not required if the person to be restrained has used, or has threatened to use, violence against the person requesting to be protected, has stalked the person requesting to be protected, or has acted or spoken in some other way that makes the person requesting to be protected reasonably fear that violence may occur.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Note: You should file this type of restraining order if you are trying to restrain an aunt, uncle, cousin, niece, nephew, great-grandparent, great-grandchild or someone not related to you such as a friend, classmate, neighbor, or roommate. If the person that you are trying to restrain is related to you in another manner, or if you have had a dating relationship with that person, please speak with clerk about a domestic violence restraining order.

INSTRUCTIONS: Print or type all paperwork <u>neatly (legibly)</u> in black or blue ink.

- **Fill out 1 original of the CH-100 form and make a copy if possible.** You are not required to make a copy of the CH-100 for filing, but it is recommended that you make one copy for yourself.
- Fill out 1 original of each of the following forms: CLETS-001, CH-109, CH-110 and CH-130.
- Turn the forms in at the Clerk's Office.

After the ex parte decision on your request for a Temporary Restraining Order, pick up 3 certified copies of your paperwork and Civil Harassment Packet #B2 from the Clerk's Office for service.
