Contestants must be residents of Mendocino County. With so much natural artistic talent in the County, the Court wants to highlight and recognize the many accomplished photographers that capture the essence of Mendocino County - its history, its natural beauty and its people. The Court is seeking photo submissions in the following categories:

1. Mendocino Coastline
2. Mendocino Redwoods
3. Significant Mendocino Landmarks
4. Tribal Communities in Mendocino
5. People of Mendocino County, past and present
6. Wildlife – Birds, Marine Life, Animals
7. Mendocino Agriculture and Industry

The deadline to submit photos is July 31, 2026. The top two photos in each category will be reproduced for display in the new building. The court will size and hang the winning photographs in the public areas of the new courthouse. The title of the photo and the photographer's name will be placed next to each photo to recognize their work.

A panel of experts from museums and art schools will rate each of the photos. All contestants will be notified in August or September of the winning photos.
